<p>This reprogramming action transfers \$15.0 million from Research, Development, Test, & Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 98/99, to Research, Development, Test & Evaluation, Navy, 98/99. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 105-56, the DoD Appropriations Act, 1998, and section 1001 of Public Law 105-85, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 1998. Reclassification is required to properly execute funds in accordance with congressional intent. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action does not affect Joint Military Intelligence Programs, the National Foreign Intelligence Program, and the Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities. It is not reflected in the FY 2000 President's budget.</p>

<p><u>Explanation:</u> In FY 1999, the Congress rescinded \$15.0 million from Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy (RDT&E, N), 98/99, for the High Power Discriminator. Funds had already been transferred, however, to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 98/99, appropriation, via DD 1415 Reprogramming Action FY 98-33 IR, for execution by the Ballistic Missile Defense Organization. Therefore, in order to implement the rescission as intended, action is necessary to transfer the \$15.0 million back into RDT&E, N.</p>
