This internal reprogramming action transfers \$500 million from the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, FY 1999, appropriation. The purpose of this reprogramming action is to meet the initial cost of Army peacekeeping forces deployed to Kosovo and is consistent with the provisions and authority enacted by Public Law 106-31, the 1999 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action does not affect the National Foreign Intelligence Program, Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA), or Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP). This action is not reflected in the FY 2000 President's budget.
