This internal reprogramming action transfers \$43.3 million between various Operation & Maintenance (O&M) and Military Personnel appropriations to redistribute the foreign currency exchange rates reductions included in the FY 1999 DoD Appropriations Act (Public Law 105-262) on an equitable basis based on the exchange rates approved for execution. This transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This realignment requires the use of general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 105-262, DoD Appropriations Act, 1999, and section 1001 of Public Law 105-261, the Strom Thurmond National Defense Authorization Act for FY 1999. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This action does not affect the National Foreign Intelligence Program, Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA), or Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP). This action is not reflected in the FY 2000 President's budget.

Explanation: The FY 1999 DoD Appropriations Act (P.L. 105-262) reduced Operation and Maintenance (O&M) and Military Personnel appropriations by a total of \$193.6 million based on anticipated foreign currency rate gains. Further, the congressional distribution of the reduction by appropriation was not consistent with the actual impact of such a change in foreign currency exchange rates. To correct the distribution of the reduction, this reprogramming uses general transfer authority to redistribute \$43.294 million of the congressional reduction.
