The transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-79, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2000; and section 1001 of Public Law 106-65, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2000. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: The Logistics Engineering Change Proposal (LECP) initiative provides for the purchase and the installation of improved aviation depot level reparables (AVDLRs) in Naval and Marine Corps aircraft. These improved AVDLRs, while typically more expensive initially, are designed to last longer and/or require less maintenance than their predecessors, thus making them more economical in the long run. The FY 2000 funding for all LECPs was provided in the O&M, Navy appropriation, even though some AVDLRs would be installed in Reserve aircraft. This reprogramming action transfers some of these funds to the O&M, Navy Reserve appropriation for the purchase and installation of improved AVDLRs programmed for reserve aircraft.
