<p>This internal reprogramming action accomplishes two functions. First, it transfers \$4 million back to the Overseas Contingency Operations Transfer Fund (OCOTF) from the Navy Reserve. These funds were originally provided to support contingency operational requirements; however, they are being transferred back due to revised force requirements. Secondly, this internal reprogramming transfers \$1,490.5 million from the OCOTF to the Components' FY 2000 Operation and Maintenance appropriations as well as the Defense Health Program. The purpose of this reprogramming action is to transfer these funds to the appropriations to meet the most urgent contingency requirements consistent with the provisions and authority enacted by Public Law 106-79, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2000, and the Emergency Supplemental Act, 2000.</p>
