SUBJECT: Transfer of Air Force Family Housing Construction Funds into the DoD Family Housing Improvement Fund

This memorandum provides instructions for implementation of a transfer of Air Force Family Housing Construction funds into the DoD Family Housing Improvement Fund account to finance a family housing privatization project at Dyess AFB, Texas.

The transfer of \$10.5 million of Family Housing Construction, Air Force, 98/02, and \$5.8 million of Family Housing Construction, Air Force, 99/03, into the DoD Family Housing Improvement Fund is approved for implementation after September 24, 2000, if Congress has not objected to this transfer by that date.

Transfer authority is provided by section 123 of Public Law 106-52, the Military Construction Appropriations Act, 2000. A 45-day notification period (directed in report language) to the congressional committees is required prior to the transfer. The 45 days elapse on September 24, 2000.

A data sheet providing instructions for the transfer and apportionment of funds is attached. Immediate transfer and apportionment of funds on the 46th day is planned, unless one of the congressional committees objects. Therefore, the required apportionment documents and the SF 1151 (Non-Expenditure Transfer Authorization) should be ready for submittal to OMB and Treasury at that time.
