SUBJECT: Transfer of Navy/Marine Corps Family Housing Construction Funds into the DoD Family Housing Improvement Fund

This memorandum provides instructions for implementation of a transfer of Navy/Marine Corps Family Housing Construction funds into the DoD Family Housing Improvement Fund account to finance a family housing privatization project at NAS Kingsville, TX.

The transfer of \$7.55 million of Family Housing Construction, Navy and Marine Corps, 97/01, into the DoD Family Housing Improvement Fund is approved for implementation after November 2, 2000, contingent upon congressional approval.

Transfer authority is provided by section 123 of Public Law 106-246, the Military Construction Appropriations Act, 2001. A 45-day notification to the congressional committees is required prior to the transfer; November 2, 2000 is the last day of that notification period.

A data sheet providing instructions for the transfer and apportionment of funds is attached. Immediate transfer and apportionment of funds on the 46th day is planned, unless one of the congressional committees objects. Therefore, the required apportionment documents and the SF 1151 (Non-Expenditure Transfer Authorization) should be ready for submittal to OMB and Treasury at the proper time.
