

Explanation: This action will provide funding for the development effort to outfit aircraft with the capability to perform Special Operations Low-Level - II (SOLL-II) missions. The C-141B aircraft, which currently performs this mission, are scheduled to retire from the active inventory. The aircraft tasked to take over the SOLL-II mission are not outfitted to support the SOLL-II mission. With testing lag time, it is imperative that this effort be started now to ensure that the capability exists to support this unique mission. No other airframe exists that is capable of performing this mission. The total cost of the new effort is \$11.9 million, of which \$3.8 million is needed in FY 2000. The remaining \$8.1 million will be funded in FY 2001 from available resources. Excess funds are available to start the development effort from a classified program within the same program element.
