This internal reprogramming action realigns funds between line items within the Procurement, Defense-Wide, 02/04, appropriation and between program elements within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 02/03, appropriation. The realignments are required for proper execution of congressionally added funding for: the Sniper Detection System, SOF Aircraft Defense Systems, the Electronic Digital Compass, Rotary Wing UAV, Rebreather, and Surface Planing Wet Submersible. This action does not require the use of general transfer authority. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.



Explanation: The funding realignments are the net result of five transactions described below.

- The Congress added \$2.0 million in PE 1160402BB Special Operations Advanced Technology Development for SOF Aircraft Defense Systems. This program is more appropriately executed in program element (PE) 1160404BB Special Operations Tactical Systems Development, project 3284 SOF Aircraft Defensive System. This action therefore realigns the funds to the proper PE.
- The Congress added \$1.4 million in FY2002 for the Electronic Digital Compass System in RDT&E PE 1160402BB Special Operations Advanced Technology Development. Those funds are more appropriately executed in PE 1160404BB Special Operations Tactical Systems Development. This action therefore realigns \$1.4 million from PE 1160402BB to PE 1160404BB.
- The Congress added \$6.7 million in PE 1160404BB Special Operations Tactical Systems Development for Rotary Wing UAV. Currently, UAV technology efforts are being conducted within PE 1160402BB, Special Operations Special Technology. This action realigns the funds to the proper PE.
- The Congress added \$1.0 million in PE 1160404BB Special Operations Tactical Systems Development for Rebreather. This program is more appropriately executed in PE 1160407BB SOF Medical Technology. All rebreather efforts have been executed in PE 1160407BB SOF Medical Technology. This action realigns the funds to the proper PE.
- The Congress added \$3.7 million in PE 1160404BB Special Operations Tactical Systems Development for Surface Planing Wet Submersible. This add is a continuation of the FY2001 congressional add that is being executed from PE 1160402BB Special Operations Special Technology. This action realigns the funds to the proper PE.
