
This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-248, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2003; and section 1001 of Public Law 107-314, the Bob Stump National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2003. This action transfers \$21.0 million from the Reserve Personnel, Air Force, 03/03, appropriation to the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 03/04, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than that for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the items.

Explanation: Funds resolution of existing deficiencies in the radar system on the WC-130J Weather Reconnaissance aircraft assigned to the Reserve's 403 Wing at Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi. The aircraft were delivered with weather avoidance radar that is not compatible with the unit's mission of flying into storms to provide tracking and severity data to ground stations. The WC-130J radar attenuates in heavy precipitation and must be modified to perform the hurricane reconnaissance mission.
