



This reprogramming action realigns \$.965 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 04/05, appropriation. This action will allow for the proper execution of funds provided by the Congress for the Aberdeen Technology Transfer Initiative. It does not change the purpose for which Congress appropriated the funds. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: The Congress provided \$1.0 million in the FY 2004 DoD Appropriations Act to be used to commence the Aberdeen Technology Transfer Initiative, which will promote technology transfer efforts at Aberdeen Proving Ground. The funding will be used for costs associated with entering into agreements with 10 to 13 Maryland companies to provide assistance to the Army in the development and testing of prototype or feasibility demonstrations and other technology improvements.
