This reprogramming action transfers funds in two parts: **Part I** transfers \$6.264 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 04/04, appropriation back to the Iraq Freedom Fund, 03/04, appropriation. **Part II** transfers \$3 thousand to Procurement of Ammunition, Air Force, 04/06, appropriation, and \$6,260,903 million to Other Procurement, Air Force, 04/06 appropriation for proper execution. These funds were originally transferred to the Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 04/04, appropriation in reprogramming action FY 04-28 IR dated February 10, 2004. Subsequently, the U.S. Central Command (CENTCOM) identified that a portion of the funds are needed for procurement items. The transfer authority is pursuant to the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003, Public Law 108-11.


