This reprogramming action transfers \$0.320 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund, 03/04, appropriation, and \$1.216 million from Iraq Freedom Fund, 04/05 to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 04/04, appropriation to finance the purchase of Improvised Explosive Devices (IED) defeat systems. This transfer authority is contained in Public Law 108-11, the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, 2003 and Public Law 108-106, the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghanistan, 2004.

Explanation: Funds will finance the purchase of 300 Channel Acorn systems, at a cost of \$1.5 million. Channel Acorn is an electronic jamming device which prevents the detonation of IED. In addition, \$36 thousand will be transferred to finance the feeding and training of search dogs that specialize in detecting mines. These dogs are used to detect the presence of IEDs in support of the Global War on Terrorism.
