This reprogramming action transfers \$4.8 million from Operation and Maintenance, Army National Guard, 05/05, appropriation to Other Procurement, Army, 05/07, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1101 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005, and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the items for which the funds are being transferred have not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: The FY 2005 DoD Appropriations Act provided \$4.8 million for Staff Management/Base Wide Protection and Facilities Monitoring Systems for the Kansas National Guard. These funds will purchase off-the-shelf software and hardware to support two-way security systems at 15 of the 55 state armories. The Congress appropriated the funds for this program to the Operation and Maintenance, Army National Guard (OMARNG) appropriation. Since this amount exceeds the threshold for this type of expenditure in OMARNG appropriation, this action transfers the funds to the correct appropriation for proper execution.
