This reprogramming action transfers \$56.050 million, appropriated in Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005, from Operation and Maintenance, Army, 04/05, appropriation to Other Procurement, Army, 04/07, appropriation to a newly established High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle (HMMWV) recapitalization line. This action uses transfer authority pursuant to 9003(a) of Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2005. This action does not change the purpose for which these funds were originally appropriated. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest, it meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the items have not been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: The HMMWV Recapitalization Program is essential to the aging fleet. A selected number of the M998A0 vehicles from the HMMWV fleet will be modified to meet the M1097R1 vehicle standard. The result of this recapitalization effort is a vehicle with an extended service life that is "like new" in appearance. The \$56.050 million was appropriated in the Title IX FY 2004 Bridge Supplemental funding for Brigade Restructuring HMMWV Recapitalization.
