Explanation: This action transfer funds for the integration and testing activities necessary to incorporate a Stepped Frequency Microwave Radiometer (SMFR) onto a WC-130J aircraft. Congress provided \$10.5 million in Public Law 108-324, the Military Construction Appropriations and Emergency Hurricane Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2005, for the procurement of "WC-130 Hurricane Tracking Equipment". However, an additional \$10.0 million is required for the integration and testing. This equipment will provide real time surface wind speeds and rainfall rates in hurricanes and tropical storms and will allow the National Hurricane Forecast Center to provide higher fidelity forecasts.
