



This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, and the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2006. This action restores funding to the source appropriations that were approved in FY 06-13 PA, Army – Navy Critical Operational Requirements. In accordance with section 1202 of Public Law 109-234, the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Hurricane Recovery, 2006; this transfer of \$1.65 billion does not count against the limitation on the amount of funds that may be transferred under section 8005. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items than those for which originally appropriated, and is determined to be necessary and in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.
