This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense (DoD) Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006. This reprogramming action also satisfies the notification requirements of section 504 of the National Security Act of 1947 (50 USC 414). This action transfers \$3.370 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 06/07, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 06/07, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.
