This internal reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. Reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. They meet all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.


Part I transfers \$70.844 million among various Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$14.585 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2007.

Part II of this reprogramming action transfers \$9.916 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 07/07, appropriation to the Services' Military Personnel, 07/07, appropriations for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Programs. These funds are transferred under the authority of section 8052 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2007.

Part III of this reprogramming action transfers \$5.968 million among various Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$2.083 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2006.

Part IV pursuant to the authorities provided by the Environmental Restoration (ER) transfer appropriation, as enacted by Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense (DoD), Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006, this action transfers \$9.010 million from the Environmental Restoration, Formerly Used Defense Sites, Defense to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 07/07, appropriation for approved environmental restoration activities. Under 10 U.S.C. 2703(c), funds transferred from the Defense ER transfer appropriations to other Defense appropriations may only be obligated or expended for environmental restoration functions.
