This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. Reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

Part I transfers \$129.770 million among the various Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$85.174 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2007.

Part II transfers \$2.454 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 06/07, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 06/07, appropriation. This reprogramming action uses \$2.454 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the DoD Appropriations, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006.
