

Explanation: Funding is transferred from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 07/07, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 07/07, appropriation to support U.S. Southern Command's counternarcotics efforts in Central America, through the construction of infrastructure facilities in Nicaragua. These projects will increase the interdiction capability of the Western Caribbean against the "go-fast" boat threat, which is transporting cocaine towards the United States.
