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This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use general or special transfer authority, exceed established reprogramming thresholds, or affect special interest items. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

<u>Part I</u> of this reprogramming action transfers \$117.671 million among various Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$111.828 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2007.

<u>Part II</u> of this reprogramming transfers \$57.0 million among Army appropriations. This reprogramming uses \$57.0 million of special transfer authority provided in section 1302 of Public Law 110-28, the United States Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007.

**Part III** of this reprogramming action transfers \$2.239 million among various Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$2.239 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2006; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006.

### Explanation:

Constant Hawk: This request funds the training, deployment and operations of three imagery analysts in Iraq to support the exploitation of Constant Hawk data. The significant contributions of the Constant Hawk systems currently deployed have been recognized by USCENTCOM which has integrated them into their operational ISR architecture. Overall system performance is directly related to the number of analysts available to support operational exploitation of the data. Additional analysts would allow faster exploitation of more data resulting in significant improvements in the scope and timeliness of the intelligence available to operational forces (\$2.0 million).

Human Terrain: When fully funded, this initiative will provide a total of 26 Human Terrain Teams (HTT) of social science and regional experts to provide "human terrain analysis" to BCT/RCT and Division Commanders in Iraq and Afghanistan. This investment will allow Army to fund social science research of local populations to support OIF Surge Brigades in priority areas as determined by CENTCOM & MNC-I and to hire and train one additional HTT. (This leverages a JIEDDO funded proof of concept that hired and trained five teams over the past ten months). It will also enable Army to keep its training infrastructure in place to meet the larger CENTCOM approved OIF and OEF Joint Urgent Operational Need Statement (JUONS) support requirement as additional funds for teams become available (\$7.910 million).
