Pursuant to authorities provided under 10 U.S.C. 2703(e), \$1.186 million and \$0.386 million were credited to the Environmental Restoration, Navy transfer appropriation and the Environmental Restoration, Formerly Used Defense Sites transfer appropriation, respectively, as a result of court settlement actions administered by the Department of Justice. An additional \$7.5 million was also credited to the Environmental Restoration, Formerly Used Defense Sites transfer appropriation by Congressional action on the Department's Omnibus 2007 Reprogramming Action (07-28 PA). This internal reprogramming action transfers these credited funds, \$1.186 million and \$7.886 million, to the Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 08/08, appropriation and the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 08/08, appropriation, respectively, for approved environmental restoration activities. Under 10 U.S.C. 2703(c), funds transferred from the various Defense Environmental Restoration transfer appropriations to other Defense appropriations may only be obligated or expended for environmental restoration functions.

Pursuant to the authorities provided under 10 U.S.C. 2703(e), additional funding was also credited to the Environmental Restoration, Defense-Wide transfer appropriation for environmental restoration activities. This internal reprogramming action transfers \$5.5 million of these credited funds from the Environmental Restoration, Defense-Wide transfer appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 08/08, appropriation for execution of approved Defense Logistics Agency environmental restoration activities. Funds transferred from any Defense Environmental Restoration transfer appropriation to other Defense appropriations may be obligated or expended only in accordance with 10 U.S.C. 2703(c).
