To transfer \$8.640 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 07/08, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 08/08, appropriation (\$.5 million); Other Procurement, Army, 08/10, appropriation (\$2.940 million); and the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 08/09, appropriation (\$5.2 million) for rapid acquisition of materiel and services to help resolve Immediate Warfighter Needs. This transfer is pursuant to authority provided in Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2007 and Public Law 110-28, U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007 for the Task Force to Improve Business and Stability in Iraq.
