This reprogramming request is submitted for prior approval because this action uses general transfer authority and exceed thresholds.

**Part I** of this reprogramming action realigns \$100.0 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 08/10, appropriation for an urgent classified requirement.

Part II of this reprogramming action transfers \$35.0 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 07/08, appropriation to the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 07/09, appropriation for an urgent classified requirement. This reprogramming action uses \$35.0 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2007. These actions reprogram funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
