This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority (GTA) and exceeds established thresholds. This reprogramming action transfers \$30.0 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 07/08, appropriation to Other Procurement, Army, 07/09, appropriation (\$22.0 million) and the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 07/08, appropriation (\$8.0 million). In addition, this action realigns \$8.0 million within the Other Procurement, Army, 07/09, appropriation. This action uses \$30.0 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2007. These actions reprogram funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.


