This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority. This action realigns \$1.5 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 07/08, appropriation and transfers \$2.385 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 07/08, appropriation to the Procurement, Marine Corps, 07/09, appropriation in support of the Combat Operation Center (COC) Super GET Trailer. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2007. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been denied previously by the Congress.

Explanation: Funding will facilitate redesign of current COC sheltered trailer, and procurement of the modified design. The trailer contains generator and environmental control units for the Marine Expeditionary Force and Division level COC. The current trailer does not provide adequate protection against the elements, nor adequate access for maintenance of equipment. The current trailer also has durability limitations that make transportation to remote locations problematic.

The amount appropriated has been reduced by \$115K due to the application of undistributed congressional reductions.
