This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

Part I of this reprogramming action transfers \$13.547 million among various Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$6.571 million in general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 110-329, the Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act, 2009; and section 1001 of Public Law 110-417, the Duncan Hunter National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2009.

Part II of this reprogramming action transfers \$52.8 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 09/09, appropriation to the National Guard Personnel, Army, 09/09, appropriation and uses \$52.8 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 9203 of Public Law 110-252, Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2009.

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Explanation: These funds pay for military personnel performing maintenance on National Guard equipment that is part of the Army's Reset program. The Army budgeted for these requirements in the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 09/09, appropriation. This action realigns the funds to the proper account for execution. The work performed is for the same purposes for which FY 2009 Bridge funding was appropriated. Specifically, the Army's Reset program includes repair of: wheeled vehicles, C4ISR (Radios, field CPUs, Telephones), small arms, support equipment (Trailers, Medical Sets, NBC Masks, Tool Kits), medical equipment, and combat vehicles. The work will be performed by over 2,000 military personnel of the Army National Guard for varying lengths of time based on mission requirements.
