This reprogramming action transfers \$21.050 million among various Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$20.050 million in general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 110-329, the Consolidated Security, Disaster Assistance, and Continuing Appropriations Act, 2009; and section 1001 of Public Law 110-417, the Duncan Hunter National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2009.
