This reprogramming action transfers \$41.0 million from the Environmental Restoration, Formerly Used Defense Sites, (FUDS), X, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 10/10, appropriation pursuant to authorities provided in Public Law 111-118, Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2010 for approved environmental restoration activities und the FUDS program. Under 10 U.S.C. 2703(c), funds transferred from the Defense Environmental Restoration transfer appropriations to other Defense appropriations may only be obligated or expended for environmental restoration functions.
