This reprogramming action transfers \$177 million from the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) Transfer Fund, 10/11, appropriation to various Defense Appropriations for execution in FY 2010. This is pursuant to the authority provided in Public Law 111-212, the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2010. It supports urgent warfighter needs for the protection of operating forces in Iraq and Afghanistan.

This reprogramming action transfers \$177 million from the MRAP Transfer Fund to Army and Navy to procure MRAP vehicle survivability upgrades and transport vehicles to Afghanistan.
