This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it exceeds established thresholds and uses general transfer authority pursuant to sections 8005 and 8007 of Public Law 111-118, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2010; and section 1001 of Public Law 111-84, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010. This action transfers \$133.3 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 10/10, appropriation; \$114.6 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 10/10, appropriation; \$18.7 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Marine Corps, 10/10 appropriation; and \$133.4 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 10/10, appropriation to the Overseas Humanitarian, Disaster, and Civic Aid, Defense, 10/11, appropriation. **I certify that this reprogramming action is an emergency requirement and is necessary to fund.** This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been denied previously by the Congress.

Explanation: The funds will provide urgent humanitarian assistance and disaster relief in response to the earthquake in Haiti on January 12, 2010, and restore OHDACA program funding temporarily used for the Haiti effort. The OHDACA requirements are actively being developed; funds will be transferred as needed to meet requirements identified by The Joint Staff and U.S. Southern Command.
