This reprogramming action transfers funds among appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress. These programs are impacted by the Military Intelligence Program (MIP).

This action transfers \$6.8 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 10/11, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 10/11, appropriation. This reprogramming action uses \$6.8 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 111-118, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2010; and section 1001 of Public Law 111-84, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2010.
