This reprogramming action transfers \$1,581.153 billion from the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) Vehicle Fund, 11/12, appropriation to various Defense appropriations for execution in FY 2011. This is pursuant to the authority provided in Public Law 111-242, the Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2011. The MRAP Vehicle program is a critical priority joint-Service program which supports urgent warfighter needs for the protection of operating forces in Iraq and Afghanistan.
