This reprogramming action is in three parts.

**Part I** transfers \$0.5 million of previously transferred drug interdiction and counter-drug activities funding from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 11/11, appropriation back to the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 10/11, appropriation, consistent with the provisions of Public Law 111-212, the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2010.

**Part II** transfers \$0.5 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 10/11, appropriation to the Procurement, Defense-Wide, 11/13, appropriation for Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO)-related drug interdiction and counter-drug activities, consistent with the provision of Public Law 111-212, the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2010.

**Part III** transfers \$396.428 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 11/11, appropriation to various Components' appropriations for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities, consistent with the provisions of Public Law 111-322, Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011.

Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Counternarcotics (CN).
