This reprogramming action transfers \$5.7 million of Operation and Maintenance (O&M), Defense-Wide (DW), 13/13, appropriation for proper execution of audit readiness activities. Of this total amount, \$3.6 million is realigned within the O&M, DW, 13/13, appropriation from the Defense Finance and Accounting Service to the Washington Headquarters Services. The remaining balance, \$2.1 million, is transferred from the O&M, DW, 13/13, appropriation to the O&M, the Defense Health Program, 13/13, appropriation (\$2.0 million) and to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, DW, 13/14, appropriation (\$0.1 million) for the Missile Defense Agency. These adjustments are required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated in Division C of Public Law 113-6, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2013. This reprogramming action uses \$2.1 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Division C of Public Law 113-6, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2013, and section 1001 of Public Law 112-239, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2013.
