This reprogramming action is submitted for approval because this action uses general transfer authority and exceeds established reprogramming thresholds. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$255.3 million from the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 11/13, appropriation to the Defense Working Capital Fund. This reprogramming action uses \$255.3 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Division A of Public Law 112-10, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2011, and section 1001 of Public Law 111-383, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2011.

Both the Chairman of the House Armed Services Committee and the Chairman of the Defense Subcommittee for the House Appropriations Committee recommended that the Department submit a reprogramming action to transfer the \$255.3 million of FY 2011/13 C-27J funding to the Defense Working Capital Fund when they denied transferring these funds to the Air Force Working Capital Fund as proposed by the Department in Reprogramming Action FY 13-17 PA.
