This reprogramming action transfers \$220.5 million from the Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund (CTPF) 15/16, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 15/15; the Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 15/15; and the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 15/15, appropriations for proper execution. This reclassification action uses \$220.5 million of the \$500.0 million provided for Syria Train and Equip (ST&E) activities in the CTPF authority pursuant to section 9016 of division C of the Public Law 113-235, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2015, and section 1209 of Public Law 113-291, the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015.

continuing resolution period for the new start initial program costs to provide immediate assistance to appropriately vetted elements of the Syrian opposition and other appropriately vetted Syrian opposition groups and individuals as authorized by section 149 of Public Law 113-164, the Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2015. As briefed to congressional staff during the presentations supporting the FY 15-02 PA, Syria Train and Equip, prior approval reprogramming request, the Department of Defense would use funds provided in the CTPF to repay the Army, Air Force, and U. S. Special Operations Command Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) programs initially used to fund the ST&E program when they became available. This is a Title IX OCO budget requirement.
