These reprogramming actions transfer funds between appropriations for proper execution. Reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$25.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 15/15, appropriation to various Components' appropriations to support Sexual Assault Special Victims' Counsel Program across the Department consistent with section 8056 of division C of Public Law 113-235, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2015.
