This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

Part I of this reprogramming action transfers \$5.5 million among Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$5.5 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public 113-235, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2015, and section 1001 of Public Law 113-291, the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2015.

Part II of this reprogramming action transfers \$0.347 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 15/15, appropriation to the Services' Military Personnel, 15/15, appropriations for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Programs. These funds are transferred pursuant to section 8052 of division C of Public Law 113-235, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2015.

Explanation: Funds are required to pay for mandays in the Special Training program supporting the Army Reserve (USAR) Sustainment Command (ARSC) DoD Acquisition Workforce Fund (DAWDF) Functional Skill Development initiative. The DAWDF allows USAR Troop Program Unit (TPU) Soldiers to receive valuable on-the-job training experience and gain proficiency in contracting and program management to meet the Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) certification standards. The TPU Soldier's Battle Training Assembly does not provide sufficient time to gain experience or become proficient in contracting processes and procedures. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This is a base budget requirement.
