This reprogramming action transfers funds between and within appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

**Part I** of this reprogramming action transfers \$4.5 million from the Department of Defense (DoD) Acquisition Workforce Development Fund, 14/16, appropriation to the Reserve Personnel, Army, 16/16, appropriation for proper execution. This reprogramming action uses \$4.5 million transfer authority pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, section 1705(e)(1).

**Part II** of this reprogramming action transfers \$4.638 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 16/16, appropriation to the Services' Military Personnel, 16/16, appropriations for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Programs. These funds are transferred pursuant to section 8053 of division C of Public Law 114-113, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2016.

The DAWDF allows United States Army Reserve Troop Program Unit (TPU) Soldiers to receive valuable on the job training experience and gain proficiency in contracting and program management to meet the Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) certification standards. The TPU Soldier's Battle Training Assembly does not provide sufficient time to gain experience or become proficient in contracting processes and procedures. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This is a base budget requirement.
