This reprogramming action transfers \$160.501 million from the Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund (CTPF), 15/16, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 16/16, appropriation to provide support and assistance to foreign security forces to conduct counterterrorism activities as authorized by section 2282 of title 10, United States Code (Authority to Build the Capacity of Foreign Security Forces). This transfer is pursuant to the authority provided in Title IX, Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO), under the heading "Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund" of division C of Public Law 113-235, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2015 and section 1534 of Public Law 113-291, the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015.

These programs and associated funding were previously notified and approved by the defense oversight committees in FY 2015 through the CTPF prior approval reprogramming action (FY15-20 PA) and the corresponding congressional notification for the use of the authority provided by section 2282 of title 10, United States Code, dated June 29, 2015. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
