This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because this action use general transfer authority, exceeds established reprogramming thresholds, and affects special interest items. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers or realigns \$15.0 million among various Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$13.6 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public Law 114-113, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2016; and section 1001 of Public Law 114-92, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2016. The funds are transferred or realigned pursuant to section 8020 of division C of Public Law 114-113, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2016 for authorized payments under the Indian Financing Act of 1974.
