This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use special transfer authority. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$18.720 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 16/16, appropriation to the Global Security Contingency Fund, 12/17, appropriation. This action is pursuant to section 9014 of division C of (Public Law 114-113), the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2016, and in accordance with section 1207 of (Public Law 112-81), as amended, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2012, related to the Ukraine Security Assistance Initiative.

FY 2016 REPROGRAMMING INCREASE: **+18,720**

Global Security Contingency Fund, 12/17 **+18,720**

Explanation: Funds are required to support training programs to assist Ukraine to develop further its Ministry of Defense and National Guard’s tactical, operational, and institutional training capacities to generate professional military forces capable of performing internal defense missions, thereby strengthening Ukraine’s resiliency against a full spectrum of hybrid threats. This is an Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) budget requirement.

FY 2016 REPROGRAMMING DECREASE: **-18,720**

Explanation: Funds are transferred from the \$250 million appropriated in section 9014 of division C of Public Law 114-113. Section 1250 of Public Law 114-92, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2016, authorized up to \$300 million for the Ukraine Security Assistance Initiative. Section 1250 (c)(1) provides for up to 20 percent of the authorized amount (\$300.0 million) to be used to support training pursuant to section 1207, of Public Law 112-81, as amended, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2012, relating to the Global Security Contingency Fund (GSCF). The Department of State and the Department of Defense signed the required joint section 1207 notification on July 11, 2016. This is Title IX OCO budget funding.
