This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$4.012 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 19/19, appropriation to the Services' Military Personnel, 19/19, appropriations for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Programs. These funds are transferred pursuant to section 8052 of division A of Public Law 115-245, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2019.
