This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

PART I of this reprogramming action transfers or realigns \$26.009 million between Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$6.0 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public Law 116-260, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2021; and section 1001 of Public Law 116-283, the William M. (Mac) Thornberry National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2021

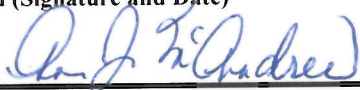
PART II of this reprogramming action transfers \$5.0 million between FY 2020 Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$5.0 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division A of Public Law 116-93, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2020; and section 1001 of Public Law 116-92, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2020.
