<u>Description</u>: Construction of a 4-lane automated MPMG range including an operations control area, control tower, classroom/storage building, bleacher enclosure, covered mess, and ammunition breakdown building.

<u>Justification</u>: This project was authorized and appropriated in fiscal year 2021 with a programmed amount of \$8.7 million. Due to extremely high bids, the project requires a new solicitation and an above threshold reprogramming of \$6.3 million to support award of the full project scope. The increase in costs is attributed to high inflation and the continuing impacts of limited supply chain and logistical interruptions and delays; increased labor and material costs; and the shortage of qualified skilled personnel in the current labor market. The project costs are supported by recent bid data.

A 10 U.S.C. §2853 cost variation notification dated July 13, 2023, was submitted to the congressional committees.

<u>Project Description</u>: Construct an MQ-9 Formal Training Unit operations facility as a secure vault to house three MQ-9 Attack Squadrons, to include Fixed Ground Control Stations (FGCS), FGCS maintenance functions, training simulators, and all other secure spaces required to support mission brief/debrief.

<u>Justification</u>: The cost increase is due higher costs for labor, materials, insurance, equipment, fuel prices, and the impact that supply chain delays have on project scheduling. Additionally, local construction market prices have increased based on material and labor supply costs.

A 10 U.S.C. §2853 cost variation notification dated August 18, 2023, was submitted to the congressional committees.
