The attached document contains the updated Department of Defense inpatient reimbursement rates for Fiscal Year 2006. These reimbursement rates were effective October 1, 2005.

The rates are used when billing for medical services provided to inpatients at military treatment facilities.

Rates and Guidance**

**1.0. Fiscal Year (FY) 2006 Inpatient Charges Effective 1 October 2005.** <sup>1/2</sup>

**Overview**

The FY06 inpatient rates are based on the direct care standardized cost per Relative Weighted Product (RWP). The RWP is a Diagnosis Related Group (DRG) based measure of the relative costliness of a given discharge. The average standardized cost per RWP for hospitals in locations with area wage rates greater than 1.0, less than or equal to 1.0, and overseas will be published annually as an inpatient Adjusted Standardized Amount (ASA). This is a change from previous years when separate ASAs were developed for Large Urban, Other Urban/Rural, and Overseas hospitals. This change makes the direct care ASA system for reimbursing military hospitals compatible, in this regard, with changes Medicare and TRICARE implemented in FY05. The military hospital's ASA will be applied to the RWP for each inpatient case, determined from the TRICARE DRG weights, outlier thresholds, and payment rules published annually for hospital reimbursement rates under the Civilian Health and Medical Program of the Uniformed Services (CHAMPUS) pursuant to 32 CFR 199.14(a)(1). Note that due to data system limitations, for military hospitals, adjustments are made for length of stay (LOS) outliers rather than high cost outliers. Each military hospital providing inpatient care has its own applied ASA rate. The hospital-specific ASA rate is the published ASA rate adjusted for area wage differences and indirect medical education (IDME) costs, if any, for the discharging hospital (see Appendix A). The military hospital-specific ASA-based amount submitted on the claim is the amount payers will use for reimbursement purposes. The individual ASAs are published on the TRICARE Management Activity (TMA) Resource Management website for the Uniform Business Office (<http://www.tricare.osd.mil>). An example of how to use a military hospital's applied ASA rate for a discharge in a specific DRG to arrive at the costs to be recovered through reimbursement is shown below.

Example of Adjusted Standardized Amounts for Inpatient Stays

Figure 1 shows examples for a non-teaching hospital (Reynolds Army Community Hospital, Fort Sill, Oklahoma) in an Area Wage Index  $\leq 1.00$  location.

a. The cost to be recovered is the appropriate ASA rate adjusted to the military hospital's location and teaching status as well as specific inpatient medical services provided. Billing in this example will be at the third party rate.

b. Example case: Discharge in DRG 020 – Nervous System Infection Except Viral Meningitis. The RWP for a non-outlier case is the CHAMPUS DRG weight of 2.2876.

c. The FY06 military hospital-applied ASA rate is \$8,289.12 (Reynolds Army Community Hospital's third party rate as shown in Appendix A).

d. The military hospital's amount to be recovered is the RWP factor (2.2876) in subparagraph b., above, multiplied by the applied ASA (\$8,289.12) in subparagraph c., above.

e. Cost to be recovered is \$18,962.19.

## **2. Reference Notes Regarding the CY 2005/FY 2006 Medical and Dental Reimbursement Rate Package**

<sup>1</sup> The inpatient full reimbursement rate per hospital discharge is based on the cost per DRG, weighted to reflect the intensity of the principal and secondary diagnoses, surgical procedures, and patient demographics. The ASA per RWP for use in the direct care system is comparable to procedures used by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and CHAMPUS. The expenses represented by the ASAs include all direct care expenses associated with direct inpatient care. The average cost per RWP for hospitals with area wage rates greater than 1.0, less than or equal to 1.0, and overseas facilities will be updated and published annually as an inpatient Adjusted Standardized Amount (ASA) and will include the cost of inpatient professional services as well as institutional costs. The inpatient full reimbursement rate does not include physical therapy and occupational therapy professional services. The DRG rates will apply to reimbursement from all sources, not just third party payers.

Military treatment facilities (MTFs) without inpatient services whose providers are performing inpatient care in a civilian facility for a DoD beneficiary can bill payers the percentage of the charge that represents professional services. The ASA rate used in these cases, based on the absence of an ASA rate for the facility, will be based on the average ASA rate for the type of metropolitan statistical area in which the MTF is located – areas with wage rate indices greater than 1.0, less than or equal to 1.0, or overseas. The UBO must receive documentation of care provided in order to produce an appropriate bill.

<sup>2</sup> Percentages can be applied when preparing bills for inpatient services. Pursuant to the provisions of 10 U.S.C. 1095, the inpatient DRG percentages are 93% hospital institutional and 7% professional charges. When preparing bills for inpatient services, professional fees (7%) are based on the privileged provider services. The hospital fees (93%) are based on the charges for support staff, facility costs, ancillary services, pharmacy, and supplies.
