I. Description of Operations Financed: Funding is to support counternarcotics and other activities for the Department of Defense and other Federal agencies for United States border security.

Narrative Justification: The Southwest Border Security funding supports operations along the United States and Mexico borders to include counternarcotics activities and assistance to other federal agencies necessary to secure the United States borders. The Department will transfer funds to appropriations for military personnel, operation and maintenance; procurement; research, development, test, and evaluation; and working capital funds for these purposes. Further, the Department of Defense may transfer up to \$100 million of this amount to any other federal appropriations accounts, with the concurrence of the head of the federal department or agency for border-related activities.

Impact if not funded: The Department and other Federal departments will not meet an urgent need for border-related activities.
