This reprogramming action transfers \$15.3 million from Reserve Personnel, Army, FY 2001, and \$12.9 million from National Guard Personnel, Army, FY 2001, to Military Personnel, Army, FY 2001, for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-259, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2001; and section 1001 of Public Law 106-398, the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2001. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.



Explanation. Funds were requested in the FY 2001 President's Budget in the Reserve Personnel, Army and the National Guard Personnel Army appropriations for subsistence for reservists and guardsmen. These funds would have been provided to the Active Army as reimbursement for reservists and guardsmen eating in Active Army dining facilities. This reprogramming action transfers funding to the Military Personnel, Army appropriation to enhance reporting of costs and to ensure proper costing in view of the increasing role that reservists and guardsmen play within the national military strategy.
